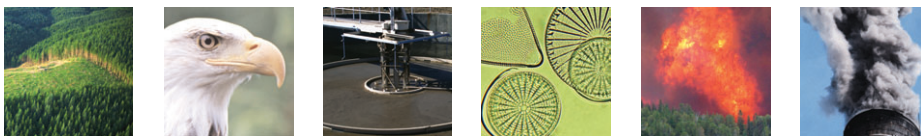


The Nicholas Institute at a Glance



Our Mission

The Nicholas Institute's mission is to become the nation's leading source of effective solutions to critical environmental problems—by providing policymakers with unbiased, science-driven evaluations of policy risks and rewards, and innovative, practical ideas for meeting complex challenges. In the short term, the Nicholas Institute aims to fill a major void in the environmental policy debate, by serving as an independent source of credible information that will be equally trusted by all parties and fully capable of bridging the divisions that too often today prevent progress on consequential issues. By the end of the decade, the Nicholas Institute aims to be the first call made by businesses seeking to craft workable strategies to address environmental problems; by policymakers seeking to understand environmental science and to draft balanced, cost-efficient legislative and regulatory solutions; and by news media seeking the best thinking and most reliable data to inform an environmental article. The Nicholas Institute is a university-wide initiative that operates in conjunction with the Nicholas School of the Environment and Earth Sciences at Duke University.
