

Nicholas Technology Advisory Committee (NicTAC)

Charter

1. Purpose

The purpose of the Nicholas Technology Advisory Committee (NicTAC) is to oversee, facilitate, and advise technology policy and practice in a manner supportive of the mission of the Nicholas School.

NicTAC achieves its purpose through regular meetings which provide a forum for the discussion of technology-related concerns, questions, and suggestions from Nicholas students, faculty, and staff. NicTAC members work with the Information Technology (IT) department and with the Dean of the Nicholas School to develop, recommend, and promote IT policies, procedures, and standards and to advise on the strategic development of IT resources and capacity.

2. Membership

The committee will consist of representatives from the Nicholas faculty, staff, and students as follows:

CSSP faculty representative designated by CSSP division chair

EOS faculty representative designated by EOS division chair

ESP faculty representative designated by ESP division chair

Master's student representative designated by the Student Advisory Committee

PhD student representative designated by the Student Advisory Committee

Staff representative designated by the Dean

Assistant Dean for Information Technology, ex officio

Members serve year-long terms and may be reappointed.
